## Ipswich League of Women Voters 2002.07

#### History

The Ipswich League of Women Voters (LWV) was an active, influential organization in Ipswich from 1957 until 1999. At its peak, membership numbered approximately 92 women in the late 1950's and early 1960's. In addition to the useful booklets and calendars the LWV prepared and distributed on a regular basis, perhaps the most useful and labor-intensive service provided was that of the Observer Corps. For each official Town meeting, such as those held by the Board of Selectmen, School Committee, and Planning Board, a League member would attend and report on the meeting according to LVW guidelines. Ipswich was fortunate to have such a vigilant watchdog organization for so many years. The LVW was also important in providing valuable voter information. Unfortunately, the group disbanded when it became apparent that fewer and fewer women had the necessary time to devote to providing such an important but unpaid public service.

#### **Scope and Content/Series Description**

The records are divided into six series: Governance, Reports, Issues, Publicity, Booklets, and Calendars. The Governance series is the backbone of the collection and is comprised of approximately seven boxes of folders in chronological order from 1957 to 1995. These Ipswich Leaguer folders contain minutes of LVW meetings, annual meeting reports, membership lists, listings of events, newsletters and related correspondence. The Reports series contains Observer Corps reports from the 1970's for Town meetings, such as the School Committee. The Issues series contains information compiled by LVW members on topics of public interest such as cable TV, nuclear power, and recycling. The Publicity series contains news clippings from the mid 1980's. The Booklet series contains the three booklets on Ipswich published by the League in 1957, 1966, and 1989. The final series contains the attractive and useful calendars prepared and distributed by the Ipswich League of Women Voters from 1980 to 1994.

The main strength of the collection is the chronological record of LVW organization and activities from 1957 to 1995. Records for the last few years of the League's existence will be donated to Ipswich Public Library at a later date.
