- 2. Go to the WiFi settings on your device and select:



FAQs

What is a hotspot and how does it work?

A mobile hotspot is a device that connects with 3G and 4G cellular networks to provide WiFi to enabled devices such as laptops, tablets, etc.

Where can I use the hotspot?

Our hotspots are connected to the T-Mobile network so they can be used in T-Mobile service areas in the United States, Canada, and Mexico.

Can I put a hold on a hotspot?

Yes, you can place a hold on a wireless hotspot through our online catalog or by calling us at 978-356-6648.

Who can borrow the hotspot?

Anyone with a library card in good standing who can pick it up at the Ipswich Public Library.

How many devices can I connect to the hotspot?

Up to 10 devices can be connected to the hotspot at a time!

What if I lose or damage the hotspot?

There is a replacement fee for lost or damaged hotspots listed online and on the kit box.

How long can I borrow the hotspot?

You can borrow the hotspot for up to 7 days.

Can I renew the hotspot?

Yes, you may have one renewal with this item if no other patron has reserved it.
