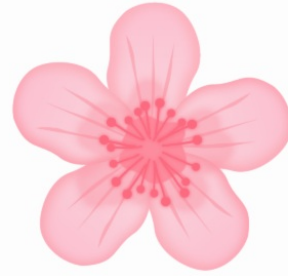

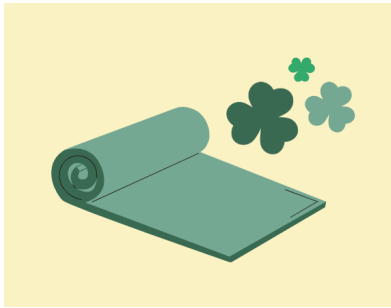
Learn to Cook with an Induction Cooktop

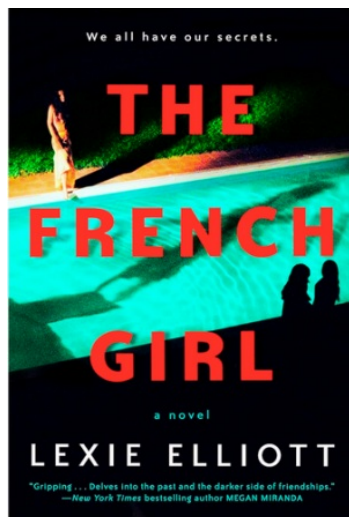
Library-Lead Book Clubs
