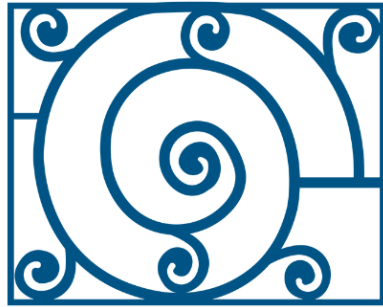

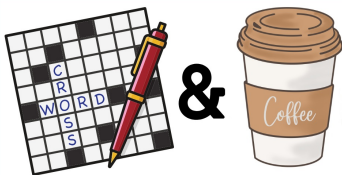

10am -12pm in the Rogers Room

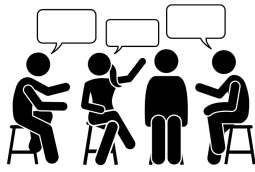


Mondays @10am

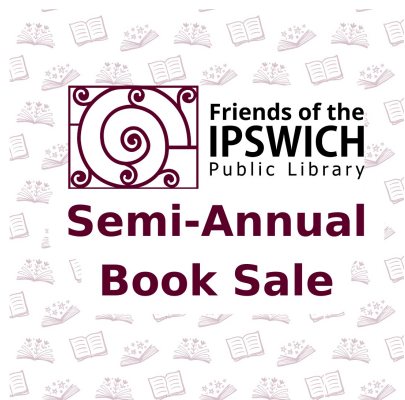


June 16th @6pm: Ipswich Public Library Book Club PM edition

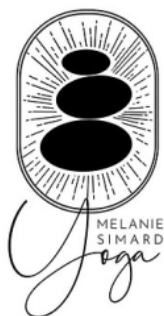

Join the Friends of the Ipswich Public Library for their Semi-Annual Book Sale! You will find lots of gems for readers of all ages. Come early and stock up!

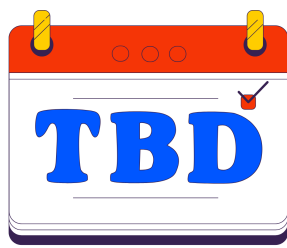


June 23rd @6pm: Gentle Yoga

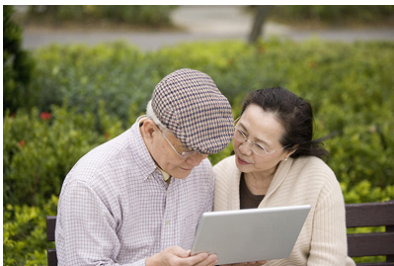
