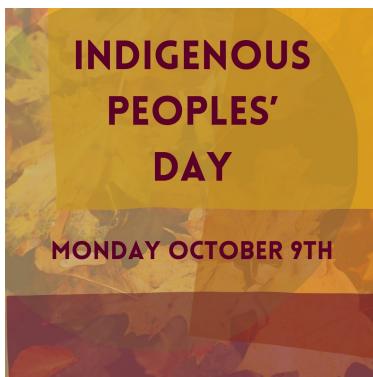

Town Meeting

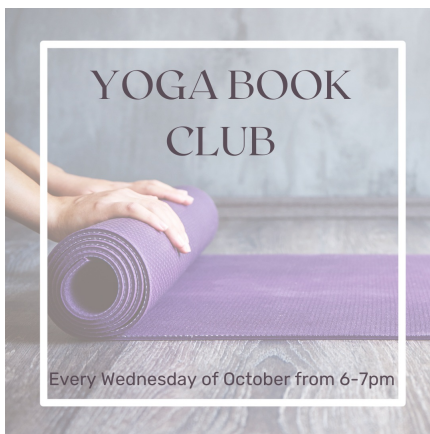
The library will be closed the evening of
